

## FACTS ABOUT THE MONDAY SEMINARY

Western Seminary/Portland, Oregon

The Monday Seminary program provides graduate level seminary education for those employed full-time who cannot attend during the regular weekday or evening schedules. The program is especially suited to those who must limit their attendance to one day per week.

### Distinctive Features

- Convenient study--most classes meet one day per week
- Concentrated study--classes meet 1-4 hours each class session
- Accessible education--classes rotate so that required subjects are available to Monday-only students.

### Benefits to New Seminary Students

- Monday students may begin seminary on a trial, part-time basis.
- Monday students may complete a seminary degree while still holding a full-time ministry or secular job.
- Monday students may enroll in all of the foundational subjects of the seminary: Bible, theology, biblical languages, pastoral ministry, intercultural studies, etc.

### Benefits to Continuing Seminary Students

- Most foundational courses will be offered during a different semester than they normally are offered during the daytime schedule. Students will have more choices for enrollment.
- Courses offered in the Monday Seminary may be applied toward Master of Divinity, Master of Arts, Graduate Studies Diploma, and Graduate Study Certificate programs.
- Three degree programs may be completed entirely through the Monday Seminary, plus four Thursday evening courses:
  - Master of Divinity -- 4 years
  - Master of Arts in Exegetical Theology -- 4 years
  - Master of Arts in Specialized Ministry -- 4 years

### Monday Seminary Class Schedule

- Monday afternoon: 1:00 - 5:10 p.m. (with two 10 minute breaks)
- Monday evening: 6:00 - 10:00 p.m. (with two 10 minute breaks)

### Tuition Costs

- \$350 per semester credit hour (\$700 for a 2 hour course; \$1400 for a 4 hour course)
- \$90 per audit hour (\$180 for a 2 hour course; \$360 for a 4 hour course)

### To Register for a Monday Seminary Course

- Notify the Admissions Office of your intent to enroll in a course. (New students complete a simple application.)
- Register for the course via SIS Online Registration. (Instructions provided to new students upon admission.)
- Pay for the course online, via telephone or in person the first week of the semester.
